...Yes. Thai culture is so intertwined with Buddhist and animist beliefs and practices that it can be hard to define a custom or value as *only* culture or *only* religion. Suppose you asked, "Why do you go to the temple on your birthday?" One Thai person would answer about making merit to earn better karma and asking for



favor for the next year. Another Thai would answer, "Because that's what Thai people do on their birthday." This worldview poses challenges for witness and discipleship, but it also opens doors to
